Utilities

Electric, water, and sewer utility services are city-owned and garbage is contracted, providing very reasonable rates for our residents.

Recycling

With the world around us turning green, Hillsboro is ahead of several small communities by providing curbside recycling. Hillsboro recycling is a single sort process where all recyclable materials go into one container. Materials accepted include:

- Glass bottles and jars
- Aluminum foil and pie tins
- Metal cans
- Plastic bottles, jars, and containers #1-7
- Paper: newsprint, office, junk mail, phone books, magazines, brown bags, boxboard, and dairy and juice containers
- Corrugated cardboard

Cardboard and paper recycling bins are also located behind the Armory at 408 First Street Southeast.

Hillsboro also provides disposal of major appliances and yard waste at the City Shop for its residents. Hillsboro residents can also get compost at the City Shop to use in their gardens.
